

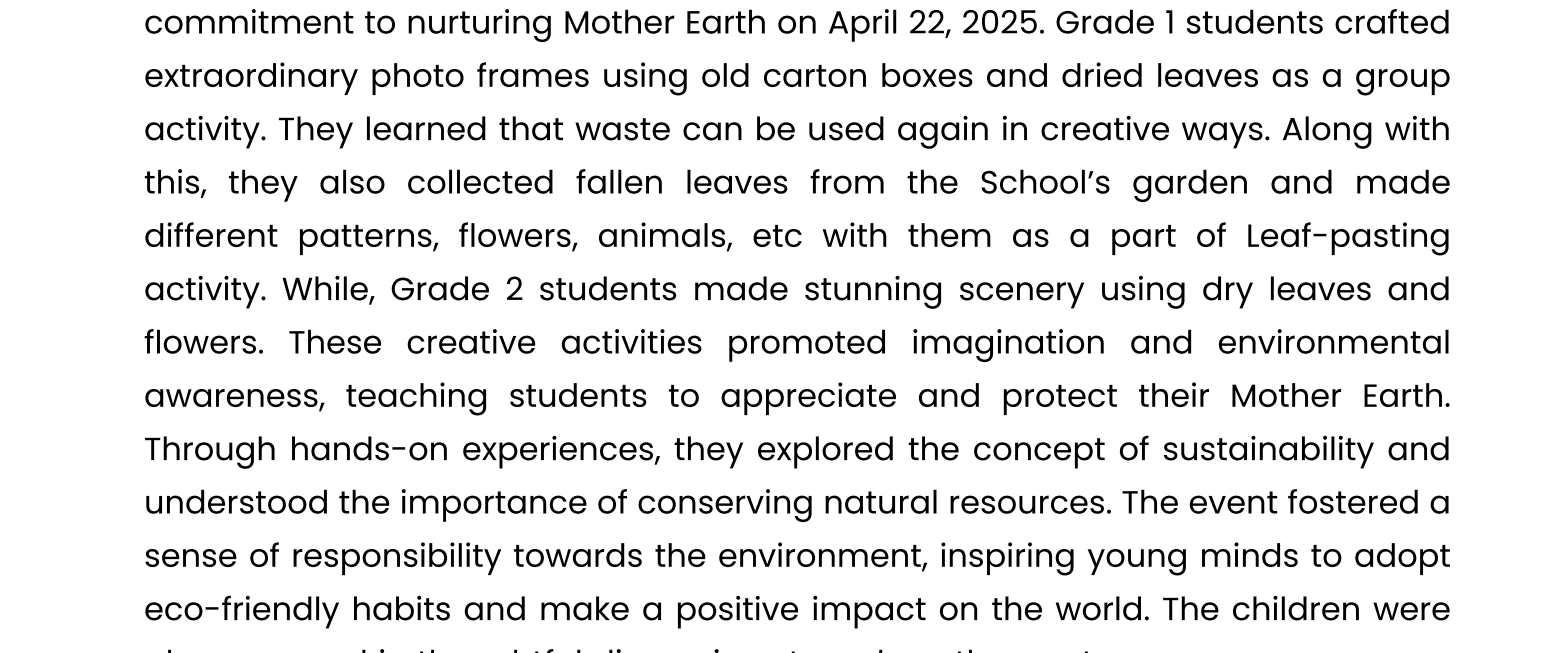
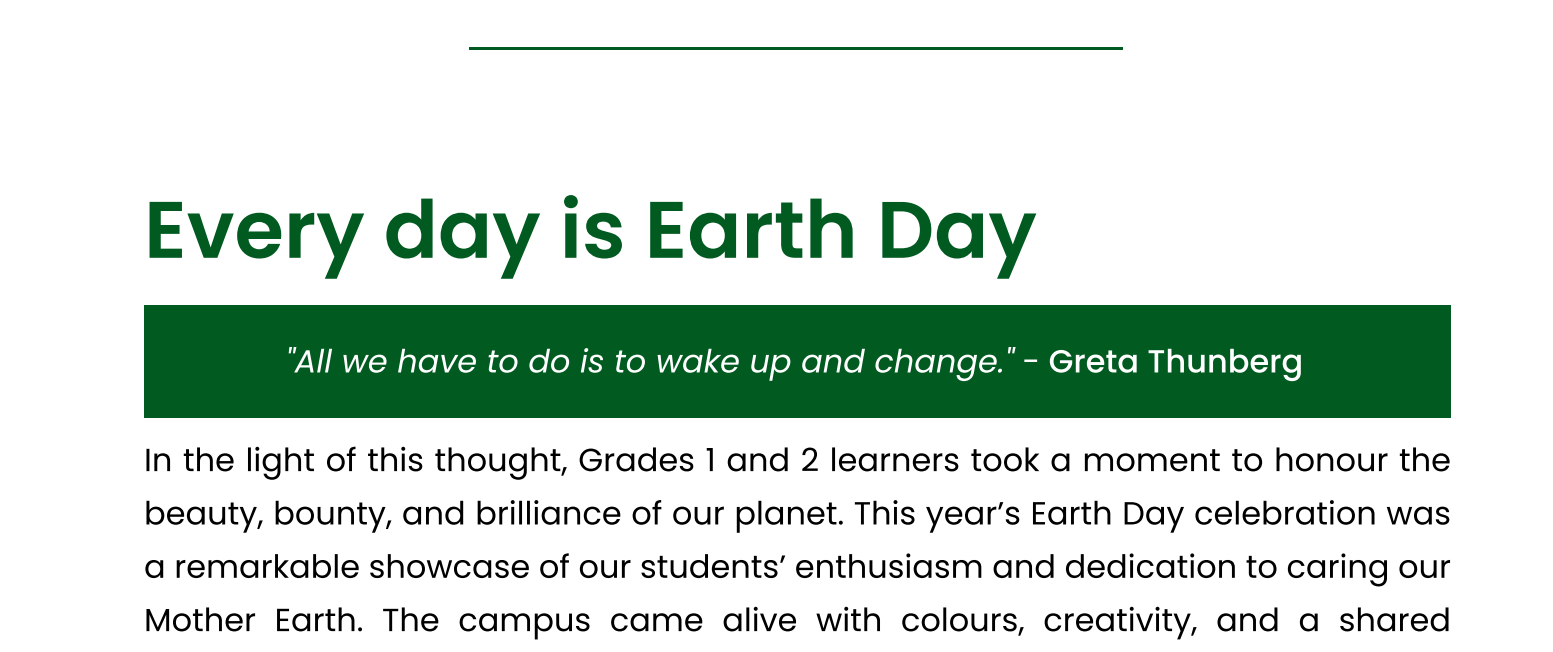
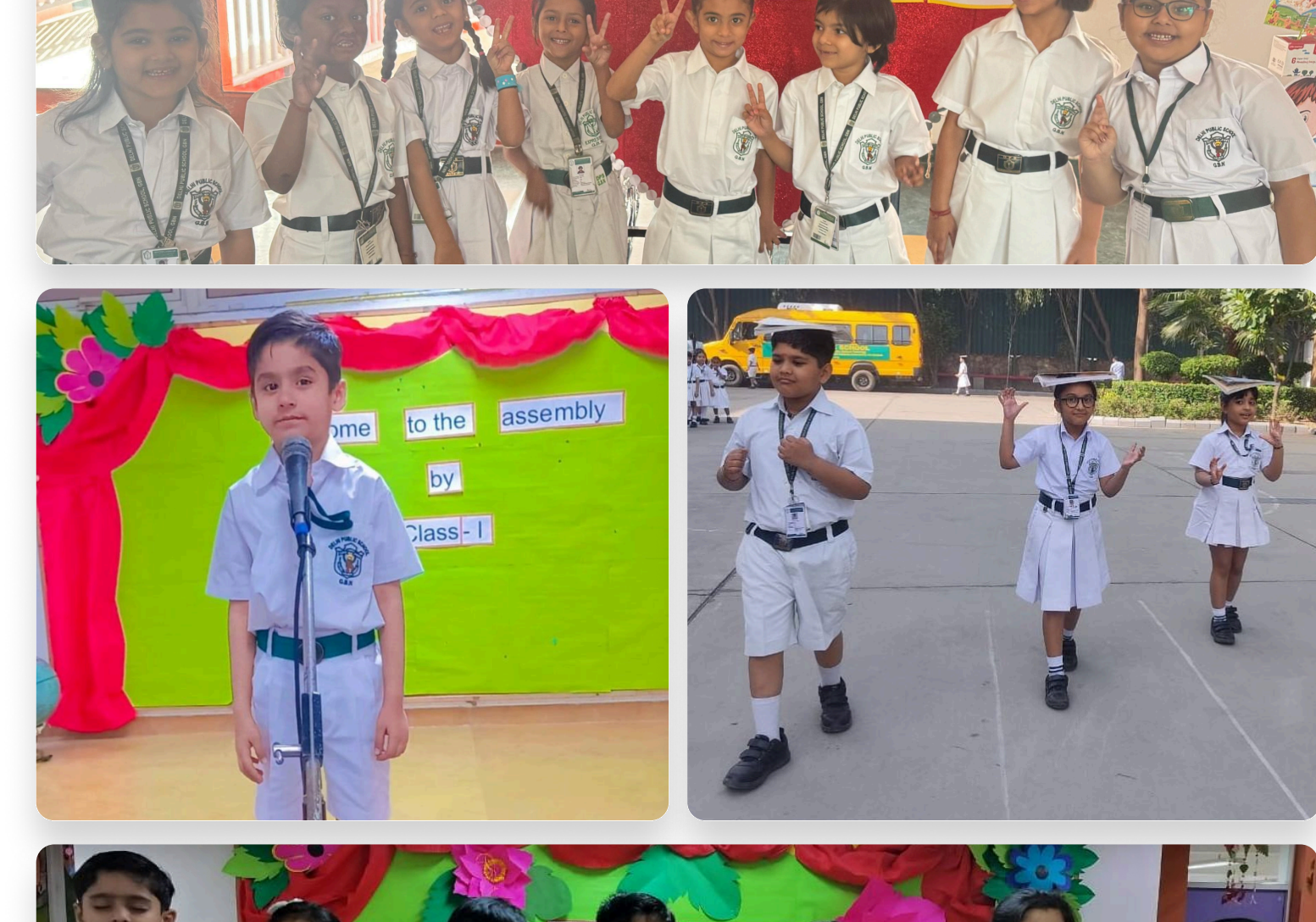


New Beginnings Bash
