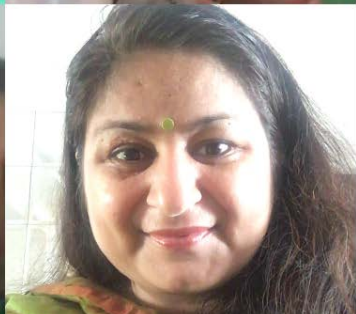

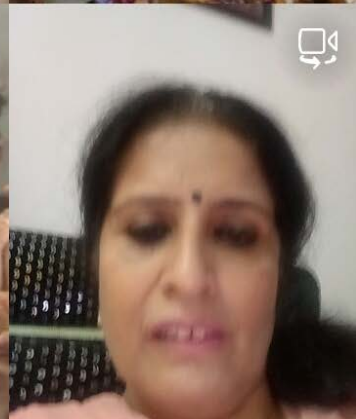

White Colour Day Celebration

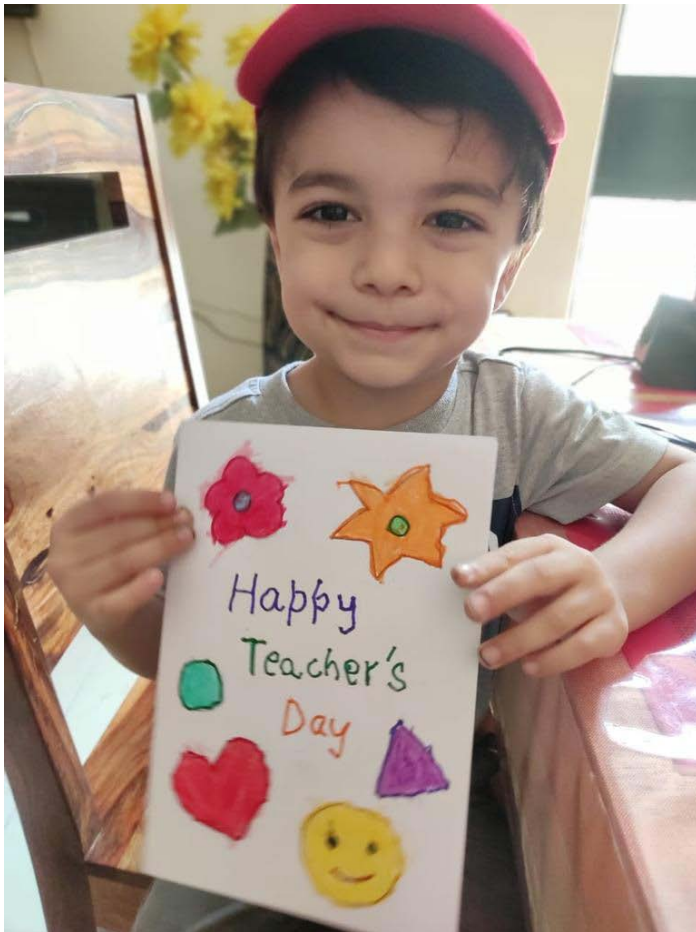
