




I Am Future Ready!

The program is designed to enhance, enable and develop problem solving and critical thinking skills through hands-on activities using coding. A 17 hour-free certification program, Learn2Code, is organized for the students. Students across all grades have enthusiastically enrolled for this program. Students will be able to learn complex concepts with ease through carefully sequenced lessons containing various interesting programs designed at different levels in the form of sessions and tutorials. All the students are eagerly waiting and looking forward to learn something new.
