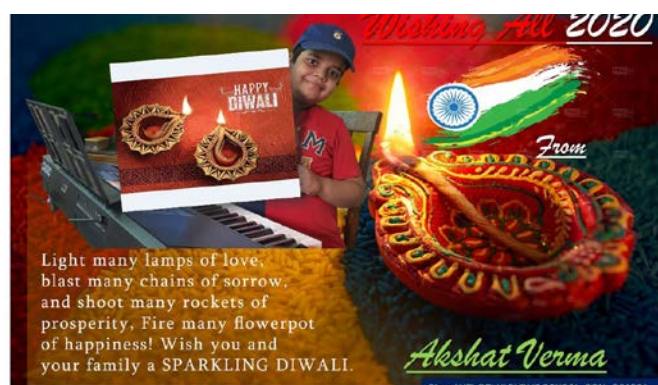

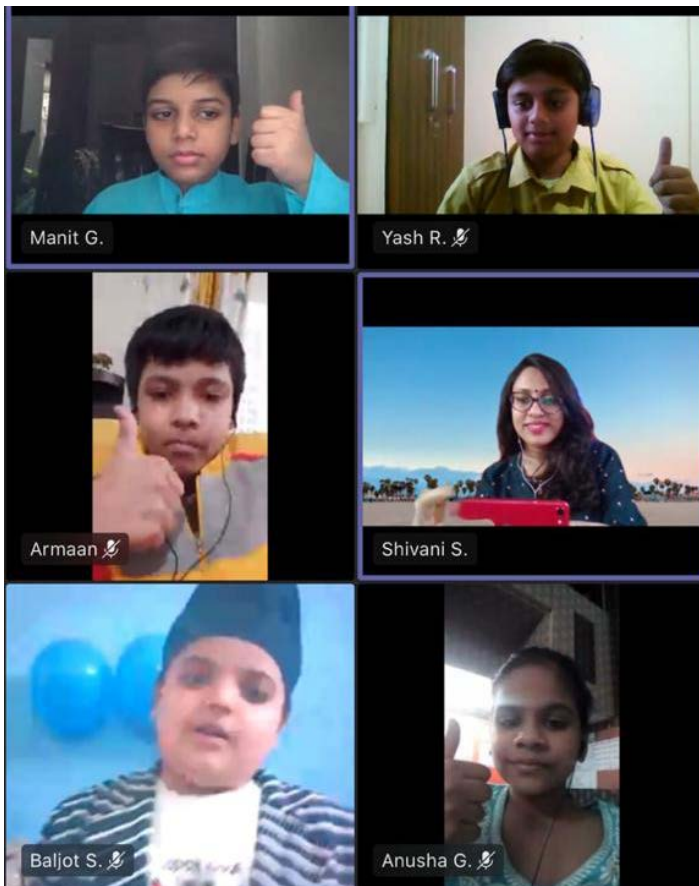
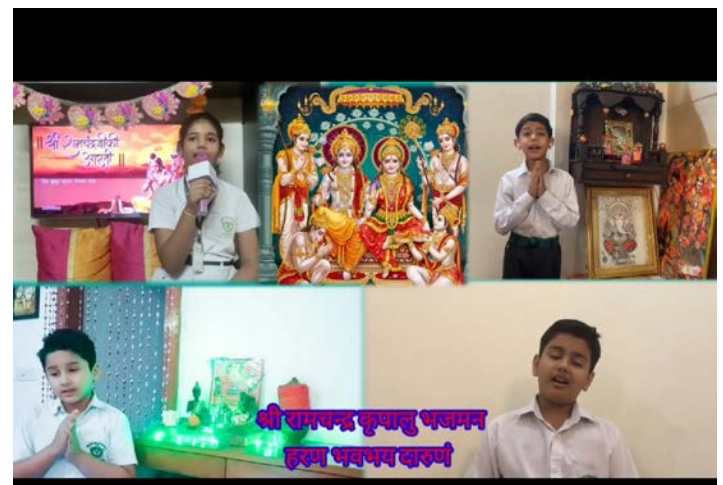

All the students took part in the activity with immense enthusiasm and vigour. They were extremely keen to solve the riddles and exhibited their impressive knowledge and great presence of mind.

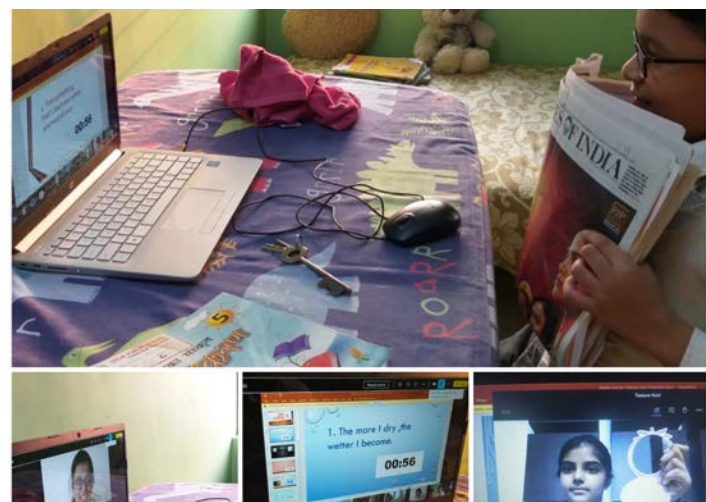
Students were felicitated with Certificates of Appreciation.
