Conducted for the students of the Primary Wing, total 8 students from class IV, 19 students from class V and 46 students from class VI enrolled for this alluring and free of cost experience.

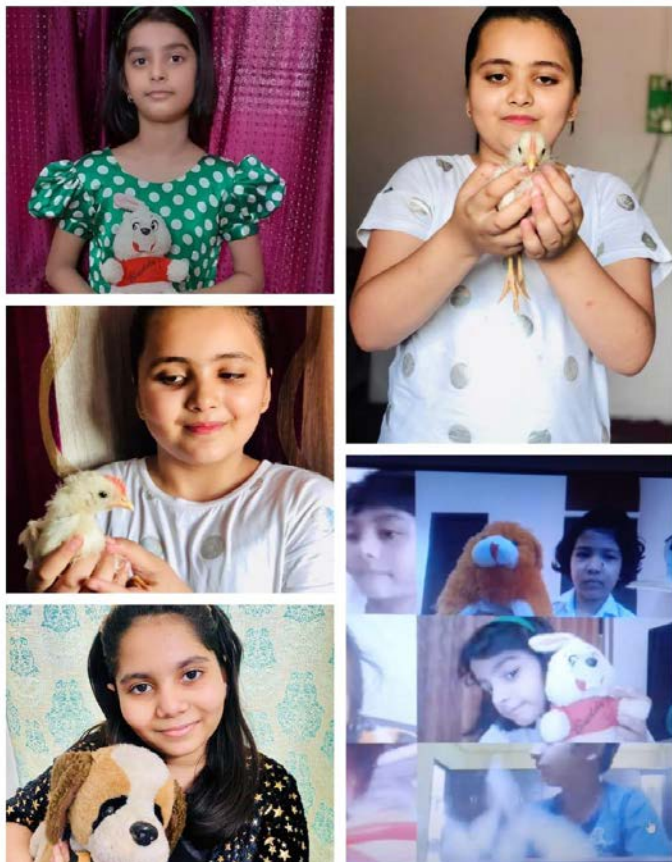
