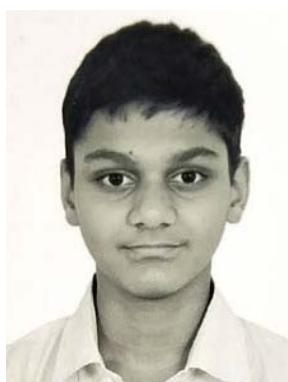

63 students out of 155 scored above 90%. The School Average is an encouraging one at- 86.469 %

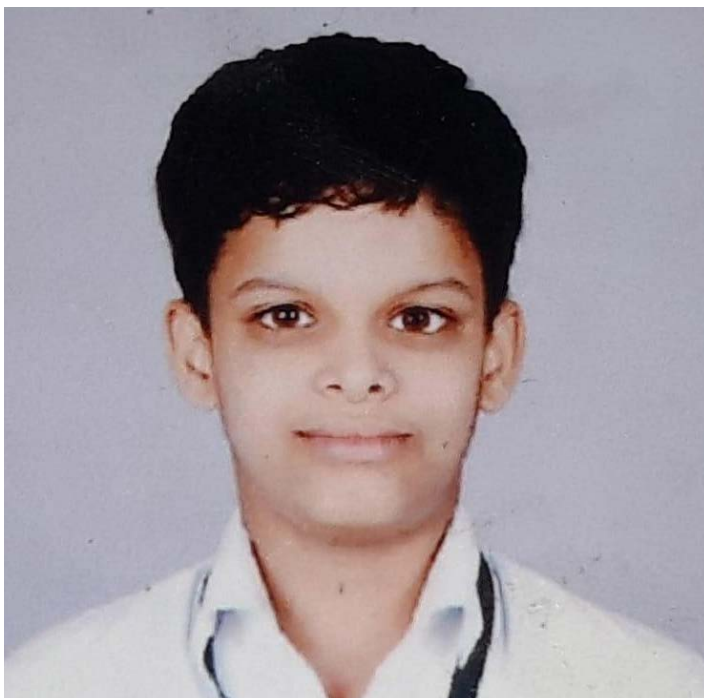
