Thank you for your continued support, and I look forward to seeing all the great things our Students, Staff and School community will achieve in the coming months.

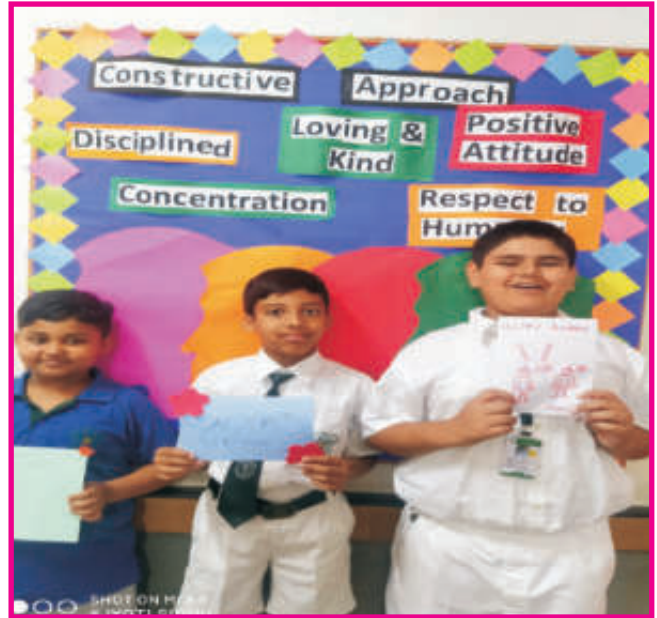

Scholar Badge Ceremony

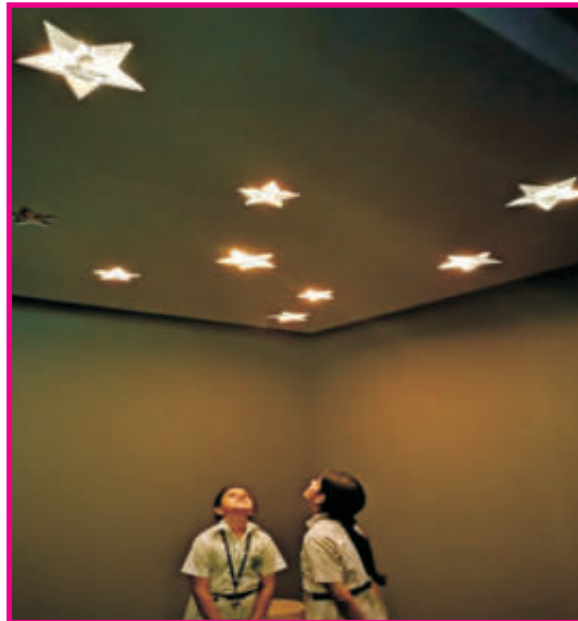
DPS, GBN Students- Winners all the Way

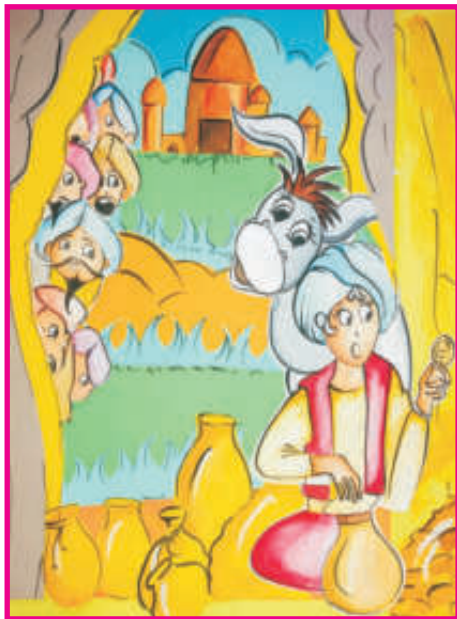


Workshops
