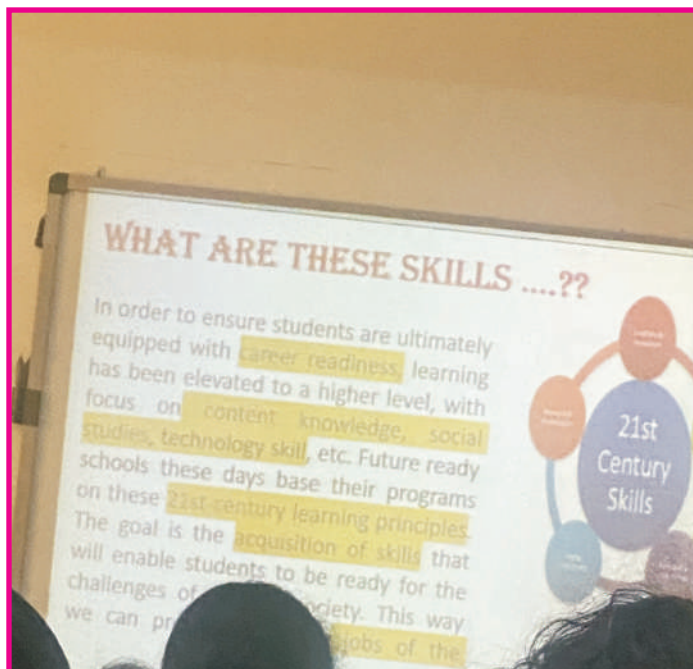
Parent Teacher Meeting

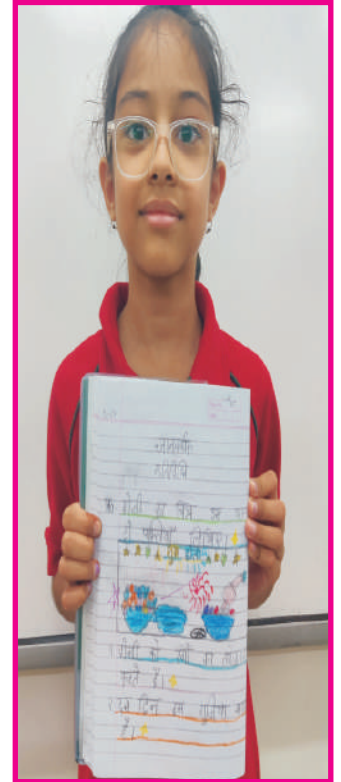
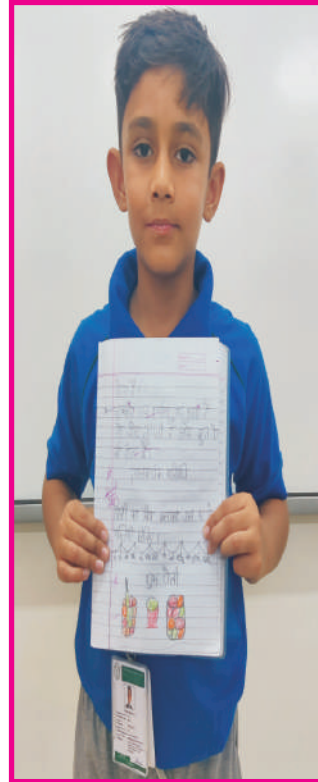
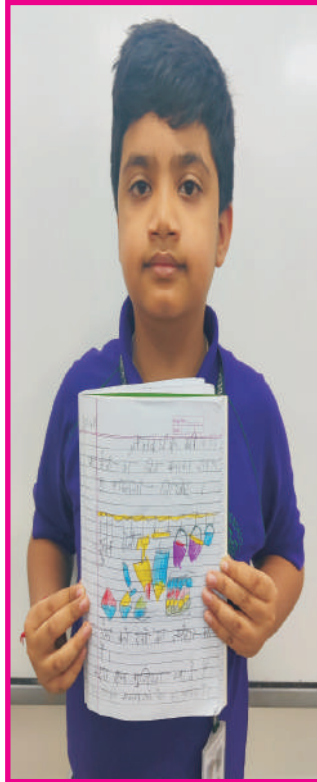


Hindi
